## A Day in the Life of Sebufu

Read through a typical day in the life of Sebufu, a student living in Uganda.  
 Whilst you read, **think carefully about the similarities and differences with your own life.**

5.00 am	<b>Wake</b> and wash. I have four younger brothers and sisters so I also have to wake them up and get them washed.
6.00 am	My parents died of AIDS so I live with my aunt. I help her make breakfast for all of us. We eat millet porridge for breakfast.
7.00 am	<b>Arrive at school</b> to play football at the school field. At 7.15 the bell goes for assembly and after that morning study period Usually I use this time to finish off homework.
8.00 am	Maths; Our class has 65 students so sometimes the teacher takes ages to help if I get stuck.
9.00 am	History
10.00 am	<b>Break</b> then science
11.00 am	We mainly learn science from books and don't do experiments very often, because we don't have equipment.
12.00 pm	<b>Lunch.</b> We pay 20,000 shillings (£6.50) a term for lunch we eat beans and Posho which is made of maize flour. After lunch I practice acrobatics with the school club. I am learning back flips.
1.00 pm	English. Our teacher was off sick so we had to take notes from a book without a teacher. Some pupils didn't complete all the work.
2.00 pm	Luganda. This is our local language and we learn it although our other lessons are taught in English which is Uganda's official language.
3.00 pm	Maths. Again!
4.00 pm	<b>School ends.</b> I get a bus to the fish market on the shore of lake Victoria.
5.00 pm	I help my uncle clean fish before we sell them. This helps me get money for my school fees.
6.00 pm	We eat matooke (savoury bananas) in the evening.
7.00 pm	Sometimes I have to clean clothes with my aunt.
8.00 pm	<b>I go to bed.</b> It gets dark at seven and we don't have electricity in our home yet.
9.00 pm	sleeping!
